A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE BID FOR THE JOHNSON ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT FROM MCCLENDON CONSTRUCTION COMPANY INC. OF BURLESON, TEXAS, FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$7,242,914.11; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Keller, Texas to design and construct the Johnson Road Reconstruction Project; and

WHEREAS, on July 20, 2021, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas approved Resolution No. 4380 authorizing the Competitive Sealed Proposal method as the best value project delivery method for the Johnson Road Reconstruction Project; and

WHEREAS, the five (5) competitive sealed proposals received on August 10, 2022 have been reviewed and evaluated in accordance with the criteria published in the request for competitive sealed proposals, and it is determined that the proposal from McClendon Construction Company, Inc. of Burleson, Texas in the amount of \$7,242,914.11 provides the best value.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the competitive sealed proposal for the Johnson Road Reconstruction Project from McClendon Construction Company, Inc. in the amount of \$7,242,914.11 is hereby approved and the City Manager is authorized to execute all contract documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said project shall be paid from the Street System Capital Improvements Project Fund, with funding provided by the General Fund, Roadway Impact Fee Fund, Keller Development Corporation Fund, and Water-wastewater Utility Fund, in the amount of \$7,242,914.11, budgeted therefor.

Section 4: THAT, this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
