RESOLUTION NO. 4344

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE BID FOR THE 2020 RESIDENTIAL STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT, FROM QUALITY EXCAVATION, OF AUBREY, TEXAS, FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,512,290.70; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Keller's Capital Improvements Program (CIP) includes an annual project to rehabilitate residential streets; and

WHEREAS, five (5) sealed bids for the 2020 Residential Street Reconstruction Project were received on February 24, 2021 and have been reviewed by staff, and it is determined that the bid from Quality Excavation, of Aubrey, Texas, in the amount of \$1,512,290.70 is the lowest and most responsible bid; and

WHEREAS, funds for this type of work was allocated as part of the Street/Sidewalk Maintenance Fund, FY 2019-20 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves the bid for the 2020 Residential Street Reconstruction Project, from Quality Excavation, of Aubrey, Texas, for the Public Works Department, in the amount of \$1,512,290.70; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all contract documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said project shall be paid from the Street System Capital Improvement Fund in the amount of \$1,512,290.70 with funding provided from the Street/Sidewalk Maintenance Fund, budgeted therefor.

Section 4: THAT, this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
