A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE AWARD OF THE PEARSON PUMP STATION VFD REPLACEMENT PROJECT TO PRATER ELECTRIC, OF ROWLETT, TEXAS FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Keller to replace the failed variable frequency drive (VFD) at the Pearson Pump Station; and

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2026, bids were received and the lowest and most responsive bid was submitted by Prater Electric, of Rowlett, Texas in the amount of \$816,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Water and Wastewater Utility Fund provides funding for the manufacturing, delivery, and installation of said replacement VFD equipment in the amount of \$816,000.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves the award of the Pearson Pump Station VFD Replacement Project to Prater Electric, of Rowlett, Texas, for the Public Works Department in the amount of \$816,000.00, and authorizes the City Manager to execute all documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas..

Section 3: THAT, the project will be funded in the Water & Wastewater Utility Capital Project Fund. Partial Funding has been provided through the Water & Wastewater Utility Fund and remaining funding will be included in the FY 2026-27 Water & Wastewater Utility Fund budget.
