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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH NEEL-SCHAFFER, OF ARLINGTON, TEXAS, TO PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES RELATED TO THE PAVEMENT MARKING PROJECT FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$70,000.00; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE ALL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

- WHEREAS, the City of Keller has a Capital Improvements Program (CIP) to maintain the street system; and
- WHEREAS, existing pavement markings along various roadways are in need of evaluation to determine reflectivity and remaining life in order to be replaced with the best value option; and
- WHEREAS, a third party professional engineering firm should be engaged to facilitate project delivery, maximize value and minimize construction timelines; and
- WHEREAS, the City Staff has reviewed the qualifications of Neel-Schaffer, of Arlington, Texas, and this firm is well qualified to provide said professional engineering services, in an amount of \$70,000.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

- Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.
- Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves a professional services agreement with Neel-Schaffer, of Arlington, Texas related to the Pavement Marking Project for the Public Works Department, in the amount of \$70,000.00; and further authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to execute all contract documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.
- Section 3: THAT, the cost of said project shall be paid from the Street System Capital Improvements Project Fund with funding provided by the General Fund, in the amount of \$70,000.00, budgeted therefor.
- Section 4: THAT, this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
