

RESOLUTION NO. 4660

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE GENERAL ELECTION DULY HELD IN THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, ON THE 6TH DAY OF MAY 2023, TO FILL THE THREE (3) YEAR TERMS FOR MAYOR, CITY COUNCIL PLACE 5, AND CITY COUNCIL PLACE 6.

WHEREAS, a General Election was duly held in the City of Keller, Texas, on the 6th day of May 2023, to elect a Mayor and Council Members to fill the three (3) year terms for Mayor, Place 5, and Place 6; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has met and canvassed the votes cast in said election; and

City Council Place 6, Ross McMullin
