

RESOLUTION NO. 4656

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S 2023 TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES SET-ASIDE (TA) CALL FOR A KELLER PEDESTRIAN FACILITIES MASTER PLAN, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$600,000.00, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City has identified the need for a comprehensive, city-wide pedestrian plan; and,

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation issued a call for projects in December 2022 for communities to apply for funding assistance through the Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside (TA) Program; and

WHEREAS, the TA funds may be used to reimburse up to 80% of the cost to develop planning documents to assist communities of any size in developing non-motorized transportation networks; and

WHEREAS the TA funds require a 20% local match and the City of Keller would be responsible for all non-reimbursable costs and 100% of overruns, if any.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby supports funding the Keller Pedestrian Facilities Master Plan project as described in the 2023 TA Detailed Application, and is willing to commit to the project's development, financing, management, adoption and implementation of completed planning documents.

Section 3: THAT, the City of Keller is willing and able to enter into an agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation by resolution should the project be selected for funding in an amount not to exceed \$600,000.00, and authorizing the City Manager to execute all documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

AND IT IS SO RESOLVED.
