RESOLUTION NO. 4601

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PROPOSAL FROM ONE SOURCE COMMERCIAL FLOORING, LLC., OF PLANO, TEXAS, FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF NEW FLOORING FOR THE JAIL AND ANIMAL SHELTER FACILITIES, THROUGH THE TEXAS ASSOCIATION OF SCHOOL BOARDS (TASB) BUYBOARD PURCHASING COOPERATIVE PROGRAM, FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$114,559.20; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller to replace the flooring in the jail and animal shelter facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Keller Crime Control Prevention District Budget includes funding for floor replacement; and

WHEREAS, the purchase from One Source Commercial Flooring, LLC., of Plano, Texas through the Texas Association of School Boards (TASB) BuyBoard Purchasing Cooperative has been determined to be the lowest and most responsible method of purchasing therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves the purchase and installation of replacement flooring from One Source Commercial Flooring, LLC., of Plano, Texas through the Texas Association of School Boards (TASB) BuyBoard Purchasing Cooperative in the total amount of \$114,559.20; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all purchase documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said purchase and installation of replacement flooring shall be paid from the Keller Crime Control Prevention District budget in the amount of \$114,559.20 budgeted therefor.
