A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING AMENDMENT NO. 4 TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH TEAGUE NALL AND PERKINS, RELATING TO THE RECONSTRUCTION OF JOHNSON ROAD FROM HALLELUJAH TRAIL TO RHONDA ROAD; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AMENDMENT NO. 4 RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City has an existing \$825,100.00, professional services contract with Teague Nall and Perkins, of Fort Worth, Texas, approved by Resolution No. 4065, amended with Resolution No. 4227, to provide engineering services for said project; and

WHEREAS, the actual cost for providing construction inspection services exceeds the estimate in the original contract; and

WHEREAS, amendment No. 4, in the amount of \$90,000, will increase the total contract amount of \$915,100.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves amendment No. 4 to the professional services agreement with Teague Nall and Perkins, relating to the reconstruction of Johnson Road from Hallelujah Trail to Rhonda Road, in the total amount of \$90,000, in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in said amendment No. 4, attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute said amendment No. 4 relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of amendment No. 4 to the professional services agreement with Teague Nall and Perkins shall be paid from the Street System Capital Improvement Project Fund, with funding provided by the General Fund, Roadway Impact Fee Fund, Street Maintenance Fund, and Water-Wastewater Utility Fund.

Section 4: THAT, this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
