A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF A 2025 VOLVO VNR DUMP TRUCK IN THE AMOUNT OF \$192,600.00 FROM VOLVO & MACK TRUCKS OF WACO, OF HEWITT, TEXAS THROUGH THE BUYBOARD COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL PURCHASE DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller to purchase a replacement dump truck for the City of Keller; and
- WHEREAS, the Proposed Fiscal Year 2024-25 General Fund and Fleet Replacement Fund budgets shall provide for the purchase of said vehicle in the amount of \$192,600.00; and
- WHEREAS, the purchase from Volvo & Mac Trucks of Waco, of Hewitt, Texas through the Buyboard Purchasing Cooperative has been determined to be the lowest and most responsible method of purchasing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

- Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.
- Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves the purchase of a replacement dump truck from Volvo & Mac Trucks of Waco, of Hewitt, Texas through the Buyboard Purchasing Cooperative in the amount of \$192,600.00; and further authorizes the Interim City Manager to execute all purchase documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.
- Section 3: THAT, the cost to purchase said dump truck, and related equipment, shall be paid from the 2024-25 Fleet Replacement Fund budget with funding provided from the General Fund, in the amount of \$192,600.00 budgeted therefor.
