A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, SUPPORTING THE FY 24 APPROPRATIONS REQUESTS TO THE OFFICE OF UNITED STATES REPRESENTATIVE BETH VAN DUYNE RELATED TO REQUESTS FOR THE BEAR CREEK WATER LINE REPLACEMENT WITH THE CITY OF SOUTHLAKE, THE SPORTS PARK REVITALIZATION, A POLICE UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLE, AND A FIRE-EMS UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLE.

- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has deemed providing exceptional public safety, public works, and recreational services as core functions of a local government; and
- WHEREAS, the dedication to these core functions is what makes Keller "Texas's Most Family-Friendly City"; and
- WHEREAS, the proposed FY 24 appropriation requests of \$30 million for water line replacement with Southlake, of \$30 million for Sports Park revitalization, of \$39,781 for a Police utility terrain vehicle (UTV) and of an estimated \$45,000 for a Fire-EMS UTV all address the core functions of a local government; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Keller and City of Southlake will provide match funding of \$7,500,000 each for a total of \$15,000,000 in match funds for the water line replacement project; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Keller will provide the match funding of \$25,000,000 for the Sports Park revitalization project; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller supports the FY 24 appropriation requests.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

- Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.
- Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves and supports the FY 24 appropriation requests to the Office of United States Representative Beth Van Duyne's related to the Bear Creek water line replacement with Southlake, the Sports Park revitalization project, a Police UTV, and a Fire-EMS UTV.
