The undersigned grant recipient hereby agrees to the following terms and conditions of the Façade Improvement Grant award for use in landscaping materials.

Clint Guin State Farm Renewed Strength (Name of Business) agrees to properly maintain all landscaping to the specifications of the City of Keller, which are summarized below.

- Provide proper hydration as needed to all trees, shrubs, flowers, vines, grasses and any plant material
- Provide proper fertilization to all of the above, regularly, as prescribed by individual plant requirements
- Provide proper general care of all landscaping on a regular schedule, including, if applicable, weekly mowing at recommended heights, edging, trimming, pruning, sucker removal, raking/leaf removal, transplanting, grooming, maintaining of espaliered shrubs and vines, deadheading as needed
- In case of plant failure, provide immediate removal, appropriate disposal and replacement in a timely manner
- Agree to purchase plant materials with warranty by retailer/supplier, if possible
- Agree to inspections from the City on a regular basis to assure quality of landscaping improvement

The City of Keller shall not be liable for any loss or damage sustained on landscaping items. The grant recipient shall hold the City of Keller whole and harmless from any and all claims for liability or damage of whatsoever nature and kind, including cost of court or attorney's fees. This contract automatically expires 24 months after fund disbursement from the City of Keller for the Façade Improvement Grant approved by City Council under Resolution No._____.

Property Beautification Project Description

This grant proposal aims to enhance the visual appeal and overall curb appeal of our business façade through a comprehensive beautification initiative. Our goal is to create a welcoming, attractive environment that reflects positively on the community and encourages greater customer engagement.

The scope of the project includes several key improvements designed to refresh and revitalize the exterior of the building and its surrounding landscape:

1. Landscaping Enhancements

We will be replanting the grass to establish a lush, green lawn that improves the property's overall aesthetics and contributes to a more inviting streetscape. In addition to the new grass, we will refresh the flower beds by laying decorative rock mulch, which will provide a clean, polished look while helping to retain soil moisture and reduce maintenance. To further accentuate the landscaping, strategically placed boulder rocks will be introduced to add natural texture and visual interest, creating focal points that complement the building's façade.

2. Building Exterior Restoration

To preserve the structural integrity and enhance the appearance of the building, we will address several maintenance issues. This includes sanding and caulking to smooth surfaces and seal gaps in the original 75-year-old wood siding, preventing moisture intrusion and improving durability. Rotten or damaged wood elements on the building will be carefully removed and replaced with new, weather-resistant materials to ensure long-term preservation.

3. Repainting

A fresh coat of paint will be applied to the entire façade, revitalizing the building's appearance with a clean, restored finish. The repainting will not only enhance curb appeal but also provide protective benefits, shielding the exterior from weather-related wear and extending the lifespan of the building materials.

Impact of the \$10,000 Grant

The \$10,000 grant will play a crucial role in the successful completion of this project by assisting with key costs associated with materials and labor. Specifically, the grant funds will enable us to:

- Purchase quality landscaping materials, including grass seed/sod, decorative rocks, and boulder accents, ensuring a professional and polished finish.
- Acquire the necessary paint, caulking, and wood replacement materials to restore and protect the building façade effectively.
- Cover labor expenses for skilled local contractors who will perform sanding, caulking, wood replacement, and painting with attention to detail and craftsmanship.

Without this financial support, the scope and quality of improvements would need to be scaled back significantly, limiting the project's overall impact. The grant ensures that we can complete all planned enhancements to a high standard, maximizing the visual transformation and contributing to a more vibrant business district.
