Consider a resolution calling the General Election for Mayor, City Council Place 5, and City Council Place 6 for the City of Keller, to be held on November 3, 2020, as set forth by the City Charter and Texas Election Code.

Item H-2

- January 21, 2020 - City Council called a General Election for the offices of Mayor, City Council Place 5 & Place 6 to be held on May 2, 2020
- March 18, 2020 - Governor Greg Abbott issued a proclamation authorizing political subdivisions that would hold elections on May 2, 2020, to move their general elections to November 3, 2020, due to public health and safety concerns related to the coronavirus (COVID-19)
- March 24, 2020 - City Council approved postponing the May 2 General Election to be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020
- Candidate filings and ballot order actions that have already taken place have been preserved
- The filing period will not be reopened, per Texas AG opinion
- Candidates may withdraw by August 24

- Order of the November 3 General Election for Mayor, Places 5 & 6
- Early voting: October 13-30
- Election Day Voting: 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Tuesday, November 3
- All registered voters will be able to vote at **any Tarrant County Early Voting locations & Election Day locations**
- If a run-off election is needed, it will be held on Tuesday, December 8
