## **RESOLUTION NO. 4322**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH CMJ ENGINEERING, INC., OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS, TO PROVIDE CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS TESTING SERVICES FOR THE KELLER SENIOR ACTIVITIES CENTER, IN A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$65,152.25; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL PURCHASE DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller to construct the Keller Senior Activities Center; and
- WHEREAS, the City's allowance budget within the Senior Activities Center construction budget provided for the purchase of said construction materials testing services; and
- WHEREAS, the purchase of said construction materials testing services from CMJ Engineering, Inc. of Fort Worth, Texas, has been determined to be the best value and most responsible method of purchasing therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

- Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.
- Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves the agreement with CMJ Engineering Inc., of Fort Worth, Texas to provide construction materials testing services for the Keller Senior Activities Center, in the amount of \$65,152.25; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all purchase documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.
- Section 3: THAT, the cost of said construction material testing services is included in the Fiscal Year 2020-21 Facility Improvement Fund, with funding provided by the Fiscal Year 2018-19 General Fund Budget and 2020 General Obligation bond Funds.
