## ORDINANCE NO. 2041

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPOINTING CAROL MONTGOMERY AS PRESIDING MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE FOR THE KELLER/COLLEYVILLE REGIONAL MUNICIPAL COURT OF RECORD, FOR A TERM OF TWO (2) YEARS, EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 2021, IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE XIV, SECTION 2-1420 OF THE CITY OF KELLER CODE OF ORDINANCES; AND THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR COMBINED MUNICIPAL COURT SERVICES BETWEEN THE CITIES OF COLLEYVILLE AND KELLER; APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF AN ASSOCIATE MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE; AND PROINDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to appoint Carol Montgomery as the Presiding Municipal Court Judge for the Keller and Colleyville Regional Municipal Court of Record for a two (2) year term in conformance with applicable law and the existing Interlocal Agreement for Combined Municipal Court Services between the cities of Keller and Colleyville; and

WHEREAS, the City Council further desires to approve the appointment of an associate Municipal Court Judge for a term running concurrent with the Presiding Judge's term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby appoints Carol Montgomery to serve as the Presiding Municipal Court Judge for the Keller/ Regional Municipal Court of Record to serve from December 1, 2021 through December 1, 2023. Accordingly, the City Council hereby approves the Regional Municipal Court Judge Agreement with Carol Montgomery attached hereto as Exhibit "A"

Section 2: THAT, the City Council further approves the appointment of Lindsay Kinzey as an Associate Municipal Court Judge for the Colleyville/Keller Regional Municipal Court of Record to serve from December 1, 2021 through December 1, 2023; subject to the terms and conditions applicable to associate judges contained in the Municipal Court ILA and Exhibit "A" hereto.

Section 3: THAT, this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
