- Ornamental greenery





Wall Mural

- Location: Old KSAC building
- Call for Art done by Public Arts Board
- Funding: Public Arts Development Fee
 Fund
- Terminus of the trail will serve as gathering space



Criteria

- Artist must reside in Texas
- Theme for mural is wildflowers
- Mural must be of original design
- Lifespan of at least 10 years
- Mural must be low maintenance, weather, vandal and graffiti resistant
- Artist shall add brick primer coat and anti-aging coating

Criteria

- Artist shall use acrylic paint.
- Content must be appropriate for all ages. The Board reserves the right to inspect all work and instruct the removal of elements.
- Designs that are vulgar, politically polarized, and contain profanity or offensive language or symbols will not be considered.
- Designs must not include advertising and soliciting, or copyrighted materials.

- Nov. 2022 Notification of phase I finalists
- Jan. 2023 Final Selection by Board
- Feb. 2023 Council Consideration
- Feb. 2023 Artist notification
- March 2023 Anticipated Start date


