

RESOLUTION NO. 3853

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF FORT WORTH AND THE CITY OF KELLER, FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A 48-INCH DIAMETER STEEL CASING FOR THE FUTURE ALTA VISTA TRANSMISSION MAIN, FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT IN THE ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$163,700.00; AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAID AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, Fort Worth has an agreement with a private developer to construct Park Vista Boulevard from Ray White Road to Keller Hicks Road, herein after referred to as the Project; and

WHEREAS, Fort Worth is cost participating in the construction of the Project; and

WHEREAS, to facilitate the future Alta Vista Transmission Main, Keller requires a 48-inch diameter steel casing be installed under Park Vista Boulevard during construction of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the costs associated with installation of the 48-inch diameter steel casing will be completely paid for by Keller by providing funds to Fort Worth; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the passage of this Resolution is in the best interest of the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

SECTION 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller hereby approves an Interlocal Agreement between the City of Fort Worth and the City of Keller, for the installation of a 48-inch diameter casing for the future Alta Vista

Transmission Main, for the Public Works Department, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", in the estimated amount of \$163,700.00.

SECTION 3: That, the City Council of Keller authorizes the City Manager to approve any final actual cost increases or decreases to the said estimated amount upon completion of the casing installation and further authorizes the City Manager to execute said agreement on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

AND IT IS SO RESOLVED.
