AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE 4 OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, BY AMENDING THE ZONING MAP AND CHANGING THE ZONING FROM PD-R (PLANNED DEVELOPMENT-6 RETAIL) AND SF-LD (SINGLE FAMILY-LOW DENSITY) TO PD-R (PLANNED DEVELOPMENT-RETAIL) FOR LOTS 1 THROUGH 8 BLOCK 1, FLOWER ADDITION, A PROPOSED RETAIL AND OFFICE PARK ON A 6.33 ACRE TRACT OF LAND OUT OF THE J. DURHAM SURVEY, ABSTRACT NO. 424, AND THE J. MARTIN SURVEY, 10 ABSTRACT NO. 1153, LOCATED ON THE NORTH SIDE OF FM 1709 (PRICE STREET), IN THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS; PROVIDING A 12 PENALTY AND AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION. 14 Hahei, Ltd., (owner/applicant), Total Program WHEREAS, (architect/developer), Management Cheatham Associates (surveyor) submitted a zoning change request (Z-98-8) which has been reviewed by the City Staff; and 20 WHEREAS, notice of a hearing before the Planning and Zoning Commission was sent to real property owners within 200 feet of the property herein described at least ten (10) days before such hearing; and 26 WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing before the City was published in a newspaper general circulation in Keller 28 fifteen (15) days before such hearing; and 30 WHEREAS, public hearings to change the zoning on the property herein described were held before the Planning and Zoning Commission and the City Council, and the Planning and Zoning 34 heretofore Commission has made recommendation to approve the zoning change request with stipulations; and 36 WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion that the zone change herein effectuated furthers the of zoning as set forth in 40 Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance and is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City of Keller, Texas, and accompanying Zoning Map are hereby amended insofar as they relate to certain located at on the north side of FM 1709 (Price Street), being a 6.33 acre tract of land out of the J. Durham Survey, Abstract No. 424, and the J. Martin Survey, Abstract No. 1153, by changing the zoning thereon from PD-R (Planned Development-Retail) and SF-LD (Single Family-Low Density) to PD-R (Planned Development-Retail) for Lots 1 through 6, Block 1, Flower Addition, a proposed retail and office park; in the City of Keller, Texas; with the following stipulations:

- 1. Reduce the landscape buffer from ten feet (10') to five feet (5') and plant one (1) tree per thirty feet (30') on center in lieu of a masonry screening wall on the east property line.
- 2. An eight-foot (8') masonry-screening wall shall be constructed on the north side of the entire property with the construction of improvements on Lots 3 and 4. An eight-foot (8') temporary wood fence shall be installed on Lots 3 and 4 and replace the existing wood fence on Lot 2 with a masonry screening wall.
- 3. Parking shall be allowed in front of the building with a thirty-foot (30') landscaping setback and four-inch (4") caliper Red Oak trees to be planted one (1) tree per thirty feet (30') in an aesthetic grouping, one-hundred percent (100%) screening of parking lots with three-foot (3') shrubs and ornamental trees of two (2) per fifty feet (50').
- 4. Pavers shall be installed at the driveway on FM 1709 (Price Street).
- Section 2: THAT, any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, as read together with the

10	Section 3: THAT, the City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to cause publication of the
