

RESOLUTION NO. 3915

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS, FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE FORT WORTH ENVIRONMENTAL COLLECTION CENTER HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE PROGRAM; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAID AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, Texas Government Code, Chapter 791, authorizes the formulation of Interlocal cooperation agreements between and among local governments; and

WHEREAS, Texas Government Code, §791.011, provides that a local government may contract with another to perform governmental functions and services, and §791.003(3)(H), defines waste disposal as a governmental function and service; and

WHEREAS, Texas Government Code, §791.025, provides that a local government may agree with another local government to purchase services; and

WHEREAS, the Cities of Keller and Fort Worth, Texas desire to enter into an Interlocal Agreement, whereby the City of Fort Worth will purchase the services of a waste disposal/recycling firm or firms, and will administer a household hazardous waste collection program, as detailed in said Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the Cities of Keller and Fort Worth mutually desire to be subject to the provisions of Texas Government Code, Chapter 791, also known as the Interlocal Cooperation Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Fort Worth, Texas, for participation in the Fort Worth Environmental Collection Center Household Hazardous Waste Program, in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in said Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit A; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute said Agreement on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost for the City of Keller's participation in the Fort Worth Environmental Collection Center Household Hazardous Waste Program, shall be paid from the General Fund, Public Works Administration Budget, contingent upon approval of the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Annual Budget.
