





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Discussion History

Ranch Serena approved for development in 1996 Cherry Grove approved for development in 2000 (Various communication between 2000 and 2012 not shown)

Sept 2012 (Ben Clark) Rancho Serena concerned about standing water
October 2012 City determines and shares that this is a private/private issue

June 2013 (Steve Terry & Kevin Quaid) HOA presidents from both subdivisions request a meeting with the city June 2013 City:

Shares drainage easement is a private item to maintain Provides documents of drainage easement Confirms/Shares that this is a private matter

April 2017 (Carla Amselmi) Rancho Serena HOA president contacts the city to request advice on options

May 2017 Rancho Serena HOA indicates that the French Drain installed on 1401 Crimson Glory (Cherry Grove subdivision) is insufficient May 2017 City:

Provides a list of hydrologists/engineers that could help define issue and provide solutions Confirms/Shares that the city does not inspect or regulate French Drains

Confirms/Shares that this is a private/private matter

April 2017 (Neil Fortner) 1317 Arboledas property owner acknowledges that the HOA's have agreed that the drainage easement should not be blocked, but it is May 2017 City:

Refers to the state water code for damages Provides a list of engineers that could advise if needed Confirms/Shares that this is a private/private issue

Nov 2017 Councilmember Bryan asks PW to look into the standing water concern and see if what the city can do help out Nov 2017 City:

Reviews documents and confirms that this is a private issue Staff confirms Cherry Grove built correctly Confirms that this is still a private matter

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Conclusion

- Both HOA's agree that this is a private/private issue
- Plat for Cherry Grove clearly calls out the drainage easement on 1401 Crimson Glory
- Cherry Grove was appropriately approved & constructed
- In Lieu of private remedy, legal remedy is guided by state statues on storm water

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
