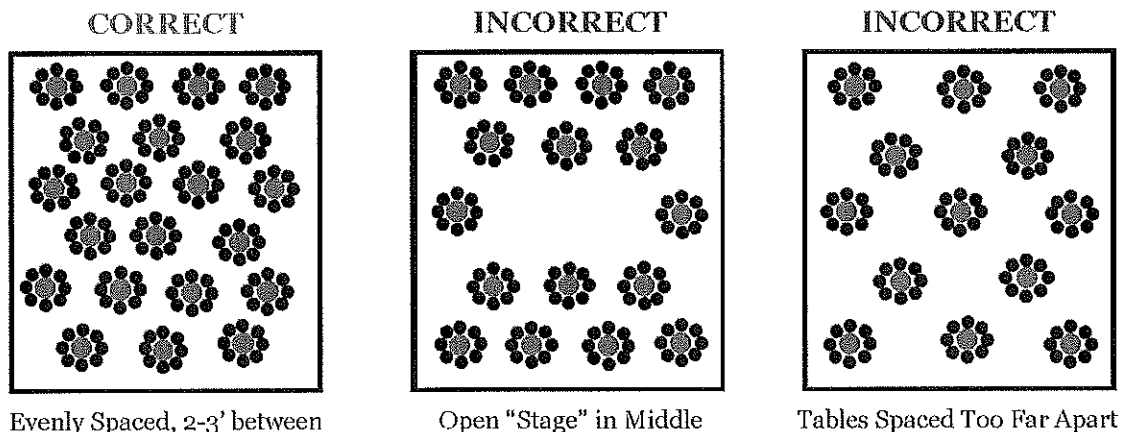

Lone Star Murder Mysteries Guidelines for a Quality Production

The following guidelines are provided to ensure the highest quality production for our clients. We ask that you take the time to address these issues so that your murder mystery dinner experience will be as enjoyable as possible.

VENUE

- **Sight:** Make sure tables are 8-10 round tops. Tables should be positioned so there are no sight-line problems. It is important to make sure every audience member can see all actors. Be aware of support columns, posts, etc. that may block view. It is a good practice to have chairs placed fully away from table as if a person is seated there and make sure to leave 2 and 1/2 feet between those extended chairs.
- **Sound:** Room should be free of outside noise. Room should be closed off (no open windows, breezeways, doorways, etc.) Room should have moderate acoustics to ensure that all audience members are able to hear actors unimpaired.



VENUE STAFF

It is important to educate the venue staff and servers who will be working with guests/audience about the etiquette of dinner theater conversation. Guests can be served during the show, but staff must do so quietly and as unobtrusively as possible. Please make sure it is understood they cannot stand by the bar/service area/sidelines and carry on conversations in normal voices. This can be very disruptive to the guests' enjoyment of the show.

SHOW TIME

Show needs to begin **no more than 15 minutes** before/after scheduled show time. **Delays over 15 minutes in length will be subject to additional fees of \$175 per each half hour delay.**

MICROPHONES: Microphones may be required for your production. This is determined by the number of guests attending and the acoustics of the room where the event is taking place. Should your event require microphones, a fee of \$250 will be charged (\$50 per microphone). This fee covers the price of the **microphones only**. Additionally, a sound system and sound technician would be required to hook up the microphones and run the sound during the performance. It is the Client's/Customer's responsibility to secure the sound system and technician with the venue. Please be sure and speak with your Lagniappe Productions customer representative to confirm whether or not microphones will be needed for your event.

FOOD SERVICE

Food service should be scheduled at least 30 minutes prior to show time. If guest will be ordering from a menu, limit selections to a few pre-determined entrees. Or have menu orders placed before arrival to venue.

SCHEDULE

If at all possible, please schedule company personnel speeches/awards presentations/etc. *after* the Murder Mystery show.

SURPRISES

Years of experience have taught us that it is never a good idea to "surprise" an audience with a murder mystery. They will enjoy it much more if they know what to expect. If they believe they will be having "dinner and drinks" and socializing all evening, they may not be prepared (or willing) to sit through a 90 minute scripted theatrical performance.

SCOOP

Inside information about your company, group, or organization can readily be worked into our existing shows. This gives each private performance a personalized touch and makes the evening more entertaining for everyone. We have provided a questionnaire that indicates the type of information we need.

TALENT GREEN ROOM

Please make sure the talent is provided a secure room for changing, preparation, and to store personal items. **Please make sure talent is provided water.**
