Ms. Susan Kenney, Director of Community Development, gave a presentation relating to Concordia, a planned development consisting of sixty-six (66) single-family residential lots and five (5) open space lots, on an approximately 23.067-acre property, addressed as 1870 Rufe Snow Drive.

A motion was made by Armin Mizani, seconded by Council Member Mitch Holmes, to approve Ordinance No. 1888 approving a Planned Development from R (Retail) to PD-SF-8.4 (Planned Development - Single Family Residential - 8,400 square-foot minimum), for Concordia, a planned development consisting of sixty-six (66) single-family residential lots and five (5) open space lots, on an approximately 23.067-acre property, being a portion of Lot 1, Block 1, A Church for the Communities, located on the north side of North Tarrant Parkway, approximately 1,000 feet from Rufe Snow Drive and North Tarrant Parkway intersection, addressed as 1870 Rufe Snow Drive.
