

# FY 2017-18 BUDGET AMENDMENT

#### **Overview**

Keller City Charter, Article VIII, Sections 8.12 and 8.13

- Proper Notice: September 2, 2018 Via Fort Worth Star Telegram
- Public Hearing: September 18, 2018 Via Regular Council Meeting

City Council adopted FY 2017-18 budget on September 18, 2017

Staff typically brings forth budget amendment as part of monitoring process or recommendations from audit

# **Proposed Budget Amendment**

| AMENDMENT ITEM                                  | AMOUNT             |
|---|--------------------|
| Self-Insurance Fund (R)                         | Up To \$ 1,200,000 |
| TIRZ Fund (E)                                   | 580,000            |
| General Fund (E)                                | 368,489            |
| Fire Station 2 & 3 Rehabilitation Project (R,E) | 315,489            |
| Vehicle & Equipment Fund (R)                    | 197,333            |
| Matching Grant Project (R,E)                    | 50,680             |

R = Revenue, E = Expenditure

### **Self Insurance Fund**

- Up to \$1,200,000 of salary savings
- "Seed money" for future self insurance
- Depended on final salary savings
- Transferred from General Fund

# **TIRZ Bond Redemption**

- Redemption = \$580,000 of future principle
- Council approved redemption July 17, 2018
- Amendment adds redemption cost in budget

# General Fund & General Government /Facilities CIP

- Total amendment = \$368,489
- Fire Station 2 & 3 Rehabilitation Project = \$315,489
  - Discussed with Council on December 19, 2017
  - Transfer to General Government/Facilities CIP
- Increased Legal Fees = \$53,000

# Fleet Replacement Fund

- Transfer from W/WW Fund to Fleet Fund of \$197,333
- Allows for future equipment replacement in FY 2019-20
  - Vac-Tron
  - Sewer-Jetter Truck
  - Wheel Loader

#### **Parks CIP**

- Increase Matching Grant Project by \$50,680
- Received 3 Grants during FY 2017-18
  - Pickleball Court Lights approved on November 7, 2017
  - Keller Sports Park Lighting approved on January 16, 2018
  - Hike and Bike Trail Improvements on May 15, 2018
- Maintains City match contribution of \$100,000

#### **Council Action**

Requires Public Hearing prior to action
