A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING A JOINT ELECTION AGREEMENT AND CONTRACT FOR ELECTION SERVICES WITH THE TARRANT COUNTY ELECTIONS ADMINISTRATOR, TO CONDUCT THE CITY OF KELLER BOND ELECTION, FOR A NEW SENIOR ACTIVITY CENTER AT JOHNSON ROAD PARK, TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2018 AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

- WHEREAS, on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, the City of Keller will conduct a Bond Election, for a new senior activity center at Johnson Road Park; and
- WHEREAS, it is desirable for voter convenience and to reduce the overall cost to each entity that said elections be held jointly on Tuesday, November 6, 2018; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas desires to select the Tarrant County Elections Administrator to conduct and coordinate the City's Bond Election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

- Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.
- Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves a Joint Election Agreement and Contract for Election Services with the Tarrant County Elections Administrator, to conduct the City of Keller Bond Election, for a new senior activity center at Johnson Road Park, to be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in said Agreement and Contract, attached hereto as Exhibit "A".
- Section 3: THAT, the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute said Agreement and Contract with the Tarrant County Elections Administrator, on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.
