#### Item F-2

Consider a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute an agreement with Watchguard Video, of Allen, Texas, for the purchase, programming, and installation of Mobile Digital Video recording systems, Body Worn Camera systems, server, software, and support equipment for the police department, through the Texas Department of Information Resources (DIR) Contract.

Approve an agreement with WatchGuard Video, of Allen, Texas to replace the Mobile Digital Video System of the Keller Police Department. Contract includes purchase of 71 Body Worn Cameras (BWC), 15 Vehicle Camera Systems (4RE), 4 Interview Room Cameras, Server & Storage, Redaction Software w/480GB Tower, Installation, 3 year hardware and software maintenance warranty, and 5 year server & storage warranty in an amount not to exceed \$315,000.00.

A contingency of \$15,000 is included with this project.

The contingency will cover:

- Installation modifications
- Touch screen monitor & computer
- Additional cabling and hardware
- Additional connect point antenna(s)
- Brackets and mounts

- The mobile digital video upgrades will address the following Items:
  - Increase video evidence capture in the field.
  - Open source video format for sharing video evidence and case filing.
  - Replace end of life mobile digital video system.
  - Improve service delivery to courts, TCDA, DCDA, and citizens requesting video.
  - Compatible with partner agency mobile digital video systems.

The Texas Department of Information Resources (DIR) Contract is a cooperative purchasing program that competitively bids contracts for state and local government. Texas DIR complies with state bidding statutes and allows the city to leverage shared purchasing power across the state of Texas.

An amount of \$325,000.00 is currently budgeted within the Keller Crime Control and Prevention District Fund for the replacement of the Mobile Digital Video System. The total cost of the replacement of the Mobile Digital Video System will not exceed \$315,000.00, which includes a \$15,000 contingency. The funds needed for the purchase will come from the Keller Crime Control and Prevention District Fund.
