A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE BID FOR WATER WELL ABANDONMENT AND ASSOCIATED DEMOLITION FOR 785 CHISHOLM TRAIL, FROM MIDWEST WRECKING COMPANY, INC., OF HURST, TEXAS, FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$65,440.00; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

- WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Keller, Texas, to abandon the water well and demolish all associated equipment at 785 Chisholm Trail; and
- WHEREAS, the two (2) sealed bids received on October 24, 2018 have been reviewed by staff, and it is determined that the bid from Midwest Wrecking Company, Inc., of Hurst, Texas, in the amount of \$65,440.00 is the lowest and most responsible bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

- Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.
- Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves the bid for the Water Well Abandonment and Associated Demolition for 785 Chisholm Trail, from Midwest Wrecking, Inc. of Hurst, Texas, for the Public Works Department, in the amount of \$65,440.00 for the bid; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all contract documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.
- Section 3: THAT, the cost of said project shall be paid from the Water-Wastewater System Capital Improvement Program Fund, in the amount of \$65,440.00 with funding provided by the Water-Wastewater Utility Fund.
- Section 4: THAT, this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
