

RESOLUTION NO. 4092

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT FOR ARTIST SERVICES AND ORIGINAL ARTWORK WITH BRAD OLDHAM SCULPTURE OF DALLAS, TEXAS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING THE DESIGN AND INSTALLATION OF AN ANIMAL-THEMED SCULPTURE AT THE CITY OF KELLER POLICE/JAIL/REGIONAL ANIMAL SERVICES FACILITY; IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$40,000.00; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Keller to install an animal-themed sculpture at the Keller Police/Jail/Regional Animal Services Facility; and

WHEREAS, the Public Arts Board conducted a limited competition and reviewed proposals from four (4) artists for the project; and

WHEREAS, the Public Arts Board considered the proposals at their November 14, 2018 meeting and unanimously voted to recommend approval of Brad Oldham Sculpture; and

WHEREAS, Brad Oldham Sculpture of Dallas, Texas is hereby recommended to provide said artist services and original artwork, in the amount of \$40,000.00, for the City of Keller Police/Jail/Regional Animal Services facility; in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the agreement for Artist Services and Original Artwork, attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves a contract agreement for Artist Services and Original Artwork with Brad Oldham Sculpture of Dallas, Texas, for the purpose of providing the design and installation of an animal-themed sculpture at the City of Keller

Police/Jail/Regional Animal Services facility; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all contract documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said Agreement for Artist Services and Original Artwork shall be paid from the Public Art Development Fee Fund.
