

RESOLUTION NO. 4097

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION FOR FUNDING UNDER THE TEXAS CONVERSION TO THE NATIONAL INCIDENT-BASED REPORTING SYSTEM (NIBRS) PROGRAM, FY 2019-20; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller, Texas, that the Texas Conversion to the National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) Program be operated for the 2020 Year, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full; and

WHEREAS, THE City Council of the City of Keller, Texas designates the City Manager for the City of Keller as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, approves submission of the grant application for the Texas Conversion to the National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) Program to the Office of the Governor; and authorizes the City Manager to execute all required documents.
