A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) REPLACEMENT FORD F-650 TRUCK IN THE AMOUNT OF \$129,436.71, IN ADVANCE OF THE ADOPTION OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2019-20 BUDGET, FROM ENTERPRISE FM TRUST OF KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL PURCHASE DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller to purchase one (1) replacement Ford F-650 truck, for the City of Keller; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2019-20 Water & Wastewater Utility Fund and Fleet Replacement Fund budgets will provide for the purchase of said vehicle in the amount of \$129,436.71; and

WHEREAS, delivery of said Ford F-650 truck is to occur within the scheduled time of the FY 2019-20 budget; and

WHEREAS, the purchase from Enterprise FM Trust, Inc. of Kansas City, Missouri has been determined to be the lowest and most responsible method of purchasing therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves the purchase of one (1) replacement Ford F-650 truck from Enterprise FM Trust of Kansas City, Missouri in the amount of \$129,436.71; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all purchase documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said purchase of one (1) replacement Ford F-650 truck, and related equipment, shall be paid from the Water & Wastewater Utility

Fund and Fleet Replacement Fund, in the amount of \$129,436.71 budgeted therefor.
