ORDINANCE NO. 1937

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING A RESIDENTIAL HOMESTEAD PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION OF 12%, AS AUTHORIZED AND DEFINED BY SECTION 11.13(N) OF THE TEXAS PROPERTY TAX CODE, IN THE CITY OF KELLER, TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS; PROVIDING A PENALTY; AND AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION.

- WHEREAS, the City of Keller would like to increase the current residential homestead exemption of 10% to 12% for a total increase of 2% in order to provide tax relief to Keller homeowners; and
- WHEREAS, the residential homestead exemption will reduce the taxable value of a homestead by the greater of either the adopted percent exemption or \$5,000.00; and
- WHEREAS, Section 11.13(n) of the Texas Property Tax Code provides that the City Council may adopt an exemption from taxation of a portion of the appraised value of the residence homestead.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

- Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.
- Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller Texas does hereby approve a residential homestead property tax exemption of 12% as authorized and defined by Section 11.13(n) of the Texas Property Tax Code.
- Section 3: THAT, this Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage.
