Replacement Funding

• 3 Methods to fund replacement

- Cash fund at time of replacement
- Prepay / Set aside for replacement
- Debt fund at time of replacement

Cash Fund

- Keller Crime Control and Prevention District (KCCPD) Police & Animal Services Equipment
- Keller Development Corporation Park Maintenance Equipment (mowers, tractors, etc.)

Replacement Funds

- Vehicle and Equipment Replacement Fund (VERF)
 - General, W/WW Utility, Drainage Funds Light & Medium Duty
 - Fire Apparatus (Engines, Ambulances)
 - Recently replaced Heavy Equipment
- IT Replacement Fund
 - Computers
 - Servers
- Facility Replacement Fund
 - Air Conditioners
 - Roofs
 - Carpet
- Fire Services / EMS Equipment Fund Proposed

Enterprise Fleet Management Services*

- Procurement of New Vehicles
 - Allows Enterprise to procure directly from Manufacturer using The Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS)
 - Negotiates additional incentives with bulk purchases
 - Works with staff to determine needs & aftermarket
- Full Management for non-public safety used at local shops in Keller
 - All routine maintenance & any mechanical repair included
 - Fixed cost
 - Does not include wear & tear items and body damage
- Maintenance Management (Public Safety) used at local shops in Keller
 - Pass through maintenance billed for any maintenance done at local shops
 - Tracks expense on a per vehicle basis data available on Enterprise's dashboard
 - EFM's ASE Certified Technician oversight & negotiation of cost
- Disposal of Vehicles
 - Determine best time to resale vehicle
 - Handle removal from fleet
 - Maximize resale opportunities
- * Relates to light and medium duty vehicles, no heavy equipment or Fire Apparatus

FY 2019-20 Replacement Summary

- Vehicle and Equipment Replacement Fund (VERF)
 - Light/Medium Duty Vehicles = 23
 - Heavy Equipment = 4
 - Ambulance Remount = 1
 - Total replacement funding = \$1,539,591
 - Total cash funding = \$719,770
- KCCPD Fund
 - 9 Replacements
 - 2 Motorcycles
 - Total cash funding = \$473,902
- KDC Fund
 - 7 Replacements
 - Total cash funding = \$239,000
- Fire/EMS Equipment Replacement
 - Begin replacement funding = \$138,023
 - Total cash funding = \$221,800

Proposed Fire / EMS Equipment Replacement Fund

- Self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) = 15 years at \$225,000
 - Required to be replaced in FY 2019-20
- Life Pack (8) = \$320,000 at 10 years
- Power Load Device (4) = \$100,000 at 10 years
- EMS Cot (4) = \$60,000 at 10 years
- Thermal Imaging Camera (6) = \$52,800 at 15 years
- Chest Compression Machine (3) = \$52,500 at 10 years
- Total Replacement Equipment = \$1,067,100
- Recommended Compressed Amount = \$138,023 for 8 years
- On-going = \$93,023 long-term
