

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING A REZONE FROM SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL - 36,000 SQUARE-FOOT MINIMUM (SF-36) TO SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL - 20,000 SQUARE-FOOT MINIMUM (SF-20), ON A 0.66-ACRE PORTION OF AN APPROXIMATELY 1.78-ACRE PROPERTY, BEING TRACT 6A, ABSTRACT 1162 OF IRENEUS NEACE SURVEY, LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF NORTH PEARSON LANE, SITUATED AT THE INTERSECTION OF FLORENCE ROAD AND NORTH PEARSON LANE, ADDRESSED AS 1016 NORTH PEARSON LANE, IN THE CITY OF KELLER, TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS; PROVIDING A PENALTY; AND AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, Michael and Maria Maguire, owner/applicant has submitted an application to the City of Keller to rezone a 0.66-acre portion of an approximately 1.78-acre property; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing before the Planning and Zoning Commission was sent to real property owners within three hundred feet (300') of the property herein described at least ten (10) days before such hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Maguires provided a support petition; and

WHEREAS, The Planning and Zoning Commission held a public hearing at its July 8, 2019 meeting and unanimously recommended approval; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing before the City Council was published in a newspaper of general circulation in Keller at least fifteen (15) days before such hearing; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion that the request of a Zoning Change herein effectuated furthers the purpose of zoning as set forth in the Unified Development Code and is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, in accordance with the Unified Development Code, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby authorizes approval of a rezone from Single Family Residential - 36,000 square-foot minimum (SF-36) to Single Family Residential - 20,000 square-foot minimum (SF-20), on a 0.66-acre portion of an approximately 1.78-acre property, being Tract 6A, Abstract 1162 of Ireneus Neace Survey, located on the west side of North Pearson Lane, situated at the intersection of Florence Road and North Pearson Lane, addressed as 1016 North Pearson Lane, in the City of Keller, Tarrant County, Texas, with the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and incorporated herein, as if fully set forth with the following condition:

1. The rezoning request from SF-36 to SF-20 shall be allowed.

Section 3: THAT, any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, as read together with the Unified Development Code and accompanying map thereto, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon final conviction therefore shall be fined in a sum not to exceed Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00). Each and every day such violation continues shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such hereunder.

Section 4: THAT, the City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to cause publication of the descriptive caption and penalty clause hereof as an alternative method of publication provided by law.
