

RESOLUTION NO. 4139

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE FY 2019-20 VEHICLE PURCHASES THRU ENTERPRISE FLEET MANAGEMENT; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL PURCHASE DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller to replace vehicles in a timely manner to avoid increased repair costs and service delivery delays; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2019-20 Vehicle and Equipment Replacement Fund will fund \$884,970 for twenty-one replacement vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Keller Crime Control and Prevention District (KCCPD) Fund will fund \$435,676 for ten vehicle replacements; and

WHEREAS, the Animal Control escrow account will fund \$52,452 for one vehicle replacement; and

WHEREAS, Exhibit "A" provides a breakdown of department, vehicle type, estimated costs, and new/replacement status; and

WHEREAS, the procurement of \$1,373,097 in vehicles thru Enterprise Fleet Management has been determined to be the lowest and most responsible method of purchasing therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves the purchase of 31 vehicles as presented in Exhibit "A" thru Enterprise Fleet Management for \$1,373,097; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all purchase documents

relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller,  
Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the costs of the vehicles purchases be split  
between the KCCPD Fund, Vehicle and Equipment  
Replacement Fund, and the Animal Control escrow  
account as presented in Exhibit "A".
