

RESOLUTION NO. 4141

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, SUPPORTING KELLER SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL CALL FOR PROJECTS AND AUTHORIZATION FOR THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is a transportation agency dedicated to delivering mobility, enabling economic opportunity and enhancing quality of life for all Texans; and,

WHEREAS, TxDOT through collaboration and leadership strives to deliver a safe, reliable and integrated transportation system that enables the movement of people and goods; and

WHEREAS, TxDOT announced a Statewide Call for Projects for the Safe Routes to School Program for sidewalk and transportation improvements on February 8, 2019 for approximately \$8.7 million in funds has been made available for eligible projects across the state; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Keller intends to submit a project application for the TxDOT Safe Routes to School Sidewalk Program project to the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) prior to the August 15, 2019 deadline; and,

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation requires the submittal of a resolution as part of the 2019 TxDOT Safe Routes to School Call for Project application submission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the City of Keller supports the Keller Safe Routes to School Sidewalk Program as applied for in the 2019 TxDOT Safe Routes to School Call for Projects application.

Section 2: THAT, the City of Keller will serve as the public sponsor and lead project contact on this project. The

City of Keller agrees to designate a single point of contact for the project.

Section 3: THAT, the City of Keller commits to fund 100% of the total project cost including construction, engineering and design if awarded 100% reimbursement for selected projects.

Section 4: THAT, the City of Keller confirms that City of Keller, not the TxDOT or any other agency, will be responsible for any cost overruns.

Section 5: THAT, the City of Keller understands and acknowledges that all awarded funding is provided on a reimbursement basis.

Section 6: THAT, the City of Keller confirms the project timeline is realistic and commits that if the project is selected for funding, an agreement (Advance Funding Agreement) will be executed within one year of selection and the project will advance to construction within three years from the date of selection or earlier.

The City of Keller City Council does hereby formally authorized submittal of an application for consideration of funding of sidewalk and related transportation improvement projects for the 2019 TxDOT Safe Routes to School Program.

This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
