Animal Shelters, Section 823.005, requires the City of Keller, Texas to appoint an advisory committee to assist in complying with the requirements of the State Health and Safety Code, Title 10. Health and Safety of Animals; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, desires to comply with the requirements of Chapter 823, Section 823.005, of the State Health and Safety Code; and
- WHEREAS, the Committee is to consist of at least one (1) licensed veterinarian, one (1) county or municipal official, one (1) person whose duties include the daily operation of an animal shelter, and one (1) representative from an animal welfare organization.
