A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITH IMS INFRASTRUCTURE MANAGEMENT SERVICES, OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDUCTING A COMPREHENSIVE STREET CONDITION INVENTORY WITH OPTIONAL ONGOING TECHNICAL SUPPORT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$110,917.00; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

- WHEREAS, the assurance of an adequate maintenance and reconstruction program for the street system is essential in maintaining the high quality of life enjoyed by the citizens of the City of Keller; and
- WHEREAS, with limited funds for street reconstruction and maintenance, it is important to ensure that funds are utilized on streets to extend their useful life while minimizing the long term capital cost; and
- WHEREAS, the City Staff has negotiated an Agreement for Professional Services with IMS Infrastructure Management Services, of Tempe, Arizona, for the purpose of conducting a comprehensive street condition inventory, for the Public Works Department, in the total amount of \$110,917.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

- Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.
- THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas Section 2: hereby approves an Agreement for Professional Services with IMS Infrastructure Management Services, of Tempe, Arizona, for the purpose of conducting a comprehensive street condition inventory, for the Public Works Department, in the total amount of \$110,917.00, in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in said Agreement, Exhibit "A"; and attached hereto as further authorizes the City Manager to execute all contract

documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said project shall be paid from the Street System Capital Improvement Fund with funding provided by the Street Maintenance Fund budget.
