## **RESOLUTION NO. 4238**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH TARRANT COUNTY, FOR THE REHABILITATION OF WHITLEY ROAD FROM BEAR CREEK PARKWAY TO RAPP ROAD, FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, during the budget process for Fiscal Year 2019-20, funding was allocated from the General Fund-Street Maintenance Fund to provide paving materials to support a project for Tarrant County personnel to rehabilitate approximately 5,267 feet of Whitley Road from Bear Creek Parkway to Rapp Road, hereinafter referred to as the Project; and

WHEREAS, Tarrant County Precinct No. 3 has agreed to provide the labor and equipment necessary for the completion of the Project; and

WHEREAS, Tarrant County Precinct No. 3 has established an Interlocal Agreement that will enable Tarrant County to provide the construction resources necessary for the Project.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas has deemed it necessary and in the best interest, health, and welfare of the citizens of Keller to move forward with the Interlocal Agreement with Tarrant County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves an Interlocal Agreement with Tarrant County for the rehabilitation and resurfacing of Whitley Road from Bear Creek Parkway to Rapp Road, for The Public Works Department, attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute said Agreement on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said Project by Tarrant County shall be paid from the Fiscal Year 2019-20 General Fund-Street Maintenance Fund, in the amount of the actual costs for materials and equipment rental which has been estimated to cost \$310,000.00, budgeted therefor.
