A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF FOUR (4) POLICE CHEVY TAHOES THROUGH ENTERPRISE FLEET MANAGEMENT AS PART OF THE FY 2020-21 VEHICLE REPLACEMENT PROGRAM; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL RELATED PURCHASE DOCUMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller to replace vehicles in a timely manner to avoid increased repair costs and service delivery delays; and

WHEREAS, the Keller Crime Control and Prevention District (KCCPD) Fund will fund \$234,505 for the four Chevy Police Tahoe replacements; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2020-21 Keller Crime Control and Prevention District (KCCPD) Fund budget will include the purchase of four replacement Police Tahoes; and

WHEREAS, the procurement of the vehicles thru Enterprise Fleet Management has been determined to be the lowest and most responsible method of purchasing therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves the purchase of four (4) Chevy Police Tahoes through Enterprise Fleet Management for \$234,505; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all purchase documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the costs of the purchase be from the KCCPD Fund.
