

RESOLUTION NO. 4250

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITH KIMLEY-HORN OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING DESIGN AND ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE OLD TOWN KELLER PHASE II PROJECT; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, on December 18, 2018 the City Council accepted the Old Town Keller Phase II Implementation Plan and Conceptual Layout developed by Kimley-Horn; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to begin pursuing the projects included in the Old Town Keller Phase II Implementation Plan and Conceptual Layout; and

WHEREAS, City Staff recommends that Kimley-Horn provide the design and engineering services for Old Town Keller Phase II with the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement for Professional Services, attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves an Agreement for Professional Services with Kimley-Horn, attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; for the purpose of providing design and engineering services for the Old Town Keller Phase II project, in the amount of \$614,730.00; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all contract documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said Agreement for Professional Services be funded from the Street System Capital Improvements Program fund with funding provided from the General Fund.

Section 4: THAT, this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
