RESOLUTION NO. 4290

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF MISCELLANEOUS CONCRETE IMPROVEMENTS FROM APEX CONCRETE CONSTRUCTION, INC. OF KELLER, TEXAS, THROUGH THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF NORTH RICHLAND HILLS, DATED JULY 19, 2005, FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$240,000, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL PURCHASE DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller to purchase Miscellaneous Concrete Improvements for the Public Works Department; and
- WHEREAS, the Proposed Fiscal Year 2020-21 Annual Budget provides for the purchase of said Miscellaneous Concrete Improvements; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Keller has entered into an Interlocal Agreement with the City of North Richland Hills, with the adoption of Resolution No. 2316, dated July 19, 2005, allowing the two cities to utilize contracts entered into by each other relative to governmental functions and services, pursuant to the authority granted by Article 791 et seq. of the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Texas Government Code; and
- WHEREAS, the City of North Richland Hills has competitively bid for Miscellaneous Concrete Improvements and Apex Concrete Construction, Inc. is the low bidder; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Keller is authorized to use the unit prices submitted by Apex Concrete Construction Inc. for Miscellaneous Concrete Improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

- Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.
- Section 2: THAT, City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves the purchase of Miscellaneous Concrete Improvements from Apex Concrete Construction of Keller, Texas, through the Interlocal Agreement with the City of North Richland Hills, dated July 19, 2005, for the Public Works Department, in an amount not to exceed \$240,000, and authorizing the City Manager to execute all purchase documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

THAT, the cost of the Miscellaneous Concrete Improvements Section 3: Purchase shall be paid from the Public Works Street Maintenance Division and CIP, budgeted therefor.
