RESOLUTION NO. 4330

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, EXTENDING THE TERMS OF APPOINTED BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS MEMBERS APPOINTED IN 2019, WITH TERMS ENDING IN 2021 BY ONE (1) YEAR.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas appoints members by a majority vote for the Planning and Zoning Commission, the Zoning Board of Adjustment, the Library Board, the Public Arts Board, the Economic Development Board, the Parks and Recreation Board, and the Keller Development Corporation; and

WHEREAS, each member of the Planning and Zoning Commission, the Zoning Board of Adjustment, the Library Board, the Public Arts Board, the Economic Development Board, the Parks and Recreation Board, and the Keller Development Corporation, serve staggered two-year terms that expire November 30; and

WHEREAS, On August 4, 2020, City Council approved Resolution No. 4268 extending the terms of appointed Boards and Commissions members with terms ending in 2020 by one (1) year, due to public health and safety concerns related to the novel coronavirus (COVID- 19); and

WHEREAS, the extension approved by Resolution No. 4268 has caused all terms of all Board and Commission members to expire in November 2021, and this new extension will bring the terms back to the staggered schedule.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the Boards and Commissions members appointed in 2019, with terms expiring in 2021 are listed in the attached "Exhibit A".

Section 3: THAT, appointed Boards and Commissions members appointed in 2019, with terms ending in 2021 are hereby extended for one (1) year.
