RESOLUTION NO. 4332

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS, FOR EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES TO PROVIDE REMOTE VIDEO MAGISTRATION IN THE KELLER REGIONAL JAIL; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, persons arrested in Tarrant County for offenses of Class B or higher are taken to Tarrant County Jail for centralized magistration; and

WHEREAS, the Tarrant County Sheriff's Office conducts a daily transport of arrested persons from Keller Regional Jail to Tarrant County; and

WHEREAS, remote video magistration will enable Tarrant County to complete magistration of arrested persons in the Keller Regional Jail and decrease in-custody times for arrested persons; and

WHEREAS, the remote magistration does not require the City of Keller to incur any additional costs or acquire new equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas has deemed it necessary and in the best interest, health, and welfare of the citizens of Keller to move forward with the Interlocal Agreement with Tarrant County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves an Interlocal Agreement with Tarrant County equipment and services to provide Remote Video Magistration in the Keller Regional Jail, attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute said Agreement on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the remote magistration service does not require the City of Keller to incur any additional costs or new equipment.
