RESOLUTION NO. 4351

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE EMERGENCY ACTION AUTHORIZING THE APPROVED BID FROM CALVARY CONSTRUCTION CO., INC., OF IRVING, TEXAS, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$158,683.64, FOR THE KELLER FIRE STATION 2 RESTORATION, DUE TO THE FEBRUARY 2021 WINTER STORM EVENT.

WHEREAS, on February 17, 2021, the fire line at Keller Fire Station 2, located at 737 Keller-Smithfield Road North, ruptured while the station crew was responding to weather related emergencies; and

WHEREAS, two (2) bids were obtained to begin immediate damage mitigation and restoration work on the station; and

WHEREAS, after review of the two (2) bids, city staff determined that the bid from Calvary Construction Co., Inc., in the total amount of \$158,683.64, was the most qualified and responsible bid; and

WHEREAS, due to the significant water damage and urgent need to begin repairs, the City Manager authorized approval of the bid so that work could begin immediately.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves the emergency action authorizing the approved bid from Calvary Construction Co., Inc., of Irving, Texas, for the Keller Fire Station 2 Restoration, due to the February 2021 Winter Storm Event, in the amount of \$158,683.64.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said Fire Station 2 Restoration shall be paid from the General Fund Fire Department budget.
