Joint Projects

- 1. Pearson & FM 1709 Intersection Improvements with Southlake
- 2. Shady Grove Road from Preston lane to Clay Hibbins Road with the City of North Richland Hills; and
- WHEREAS, it is understood that if approved by voters, the bond package would pay for fifty percent of the successful projects, with the other half coming from the City fund.
