A motion was made by Council Member Chris Whatley, seconded by Council Member Eric Schmidt, to approve Ordinance No. 1920 approving a Specific Use Permit (SUP) for Pecan Park, a single story 5,860 square-foot professional office building, located on a 0.73-acre lot, on the east side of South Pate Orr Road, approximately five hundred and fifty feet (550') northeast of the South Pate Orr Road and Bear Creek Parkway intersection, being Lot 1R, Block A, Pecan Park Addition, at 351 South Pate Orr Road, and zoned TC (Town Center) with the following conditions:

1) The request for a variance to allow the building to be single-story in height in lieu of the required two-story minimum in Town Center shall be allowed.

2) The request for a variance to allow the building to be 5,860 square feet in lieu of the required minimum of 6,000 square feet in Town Center.
