Consider a resolution casting votes for nominee(s) for the Board of Directors of the Tarrant Appraisal District for a two-year term beginning January 1, 2020.

Background:
The current terms of service for the five elected directors of the Tarrant Appraisal District expire December 31, 2019. There are ten (10) nominees for the five positions. Those selected will begin a two-year term effective January 1, 2020. Based on taxable values, the City of Keller is entitled to cast 28 votes either collectively or separately for the nominees. Votes are due no later than December 15, 2019. There are a total of 5,000 votes available to taxing entities in Tarrant County, to include cities, the county and school districts.
